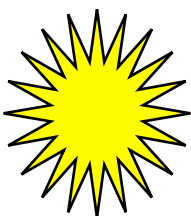

Abstract

Dr. Lippmann will focus on the ambient-air fine-particulate matter (particles with aerodynamic diameters <2.5 μm) that account for almost all of the excess annual mortality that has been associated with our exposures to air pollution.
