

## How to apply ?

First, you download the call; then you identify your research unit (SME or research centre / university and industrial partner) and at least you submit your project.

Selection process is about three months and includes an international peer review.

## When ?

Two calls for proposals per year with deadlines in March and September.

## BEWARE Fellowships: your career opportunities in Belgium

### What ?

The **Belgium Wallonia REsearch Fellowships** offer the possibility for highly skilled researchers to perform a research stay in Belgium (Wallonia and Brussels) and to benefit from the expertise of innovative SMEs, research centres or universities.

According to your expectations, two solutions are offered: **BEWARE Industry** and **BEWARE Academia**.

In both cases, research projects are jointly submitted by you and the promoter.

Whatever formula you choose, there will always be a solution to your needs. Either the SME hosts you for a fulltime job (**BEWARE Industry**) or, under contract with a university, you spend 25% of your time in a SME (**BEWARE Academia**).

### How long ?

The research stay may vary from 18 to 36 months.



### Eligible research fields

All research fields are eligible but the research project must demonstrate an innovative aspect and/or enable technology transfer.

### Who can apply ?

Researchers from all nationalities, holding a PhD or having equivalent research experience (minimum 4 years). At the closing date of the call for proposals, the researcher must be in a situation of transnational mobility (having spent less than 12 months in Belgium during the last 36 months).

### What does the fellowship include ?

- a gross annual salary, including holiday pay and year-end bonus (+/- 90,000 €)
- the personal liability insurance costs
- the contributions to the National Office of Social Security (NOSS): health care, retirement, child allowances...
- a mobility allowance of 450€/month
- 18,000€/year to cover the expenses linked to the supervision and mentorship of the researcher and other costs such as equipment, travel, consumables...
